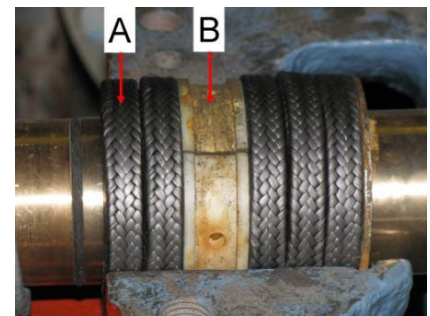




Workshop #	WW201
Workshop Name	Collection Systems Certification Exam Prep
Summary	This workshop is a very fast-moving workshop, covering as much of the material in the long-term wastewater collection systems class as is possible in only 1 1/2 days. “Sit down, strap yourself in and hang on—because we are going for a ride!” It is a great certification review for those preparing for certification exams; as well as a familiarization/preview or review for others.

Workshop Description

The Wastewater Collection Systems Certification Exam Prep. is a 1½ day workshop that is an excellent review for those who have taken a long-term class, as well as for those interested in taking Certification Exams. This is a fast-paced, information-packed workshop that will cover many wastewater collection systems subjects, such as importance of collection systems, operator certification, appurtenances, flow, basic and applied math, pumps and pumping, inspecting and testing of collection systems, and many others.



Since this workshop covers such a wide variety of topics, it can not be expected that every topic related to collection systems will be covered, nor will the topics be discussed in great depth. Rather, this is a workshop that is designed to give the operator an overview and review of some of the many collection systems topics. Operators already familiar with the topics, as well as those who are new and have little experience will get much useful information from this workshop.

Due to the fact that there is more information in the workshop manual than time allows, this is a great opportunity for course customization. The students are given the opportunity to choose what topics they want to cover (time permitting)! So, come prepared to choose what

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topics you would like to learn more about!

Bring pencils/pens and a calculator; we may be solving typical collections math problems.

NOTE: KDHE does not certify collection systems operators, nor do they give exams for collection systems. The Collection Systems Certification is a voluntary certification which is given by the ABC (*Association of Boards of Certification*), which also certifies water distribution, lab, biosolids and maintenance personnel. Although the test is not mandatory, many municipalities and organizations require it for employment and/or wage increases.
